FIRST FIRE INSPECTION VISIT SHALL BE AT NO CHARGE. THE FEE IS IMPOSED AS A RESULT OF VIOLATIONS NOT BEING CORRECTED ON THE SECOND VISIT. FAILURE TO CORRECT VIOLATIONS AFTER THE SECOND VISIT MAY RESULT IN FURTHER LEGAL ACTION BEING TAKEN.

PERMITS REQUIRED AND FEES

IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE BUILDING CODE, VOLUME V, FIRE PREVENTION, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 105, THERE SHALL BE 2 TYPES OF PERMITS ISSUED BY THE FIRE OFFICIAL. OPERATIONAL PERMITS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 105.6 AND CONSTRUCTION PERMITS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 105.7.

HAZ MAT RESPONSE

IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL AND STATE REGULATIONS, PERSONS WHO EXPERIENCE A HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SPILL, LEAK, OR RELEASE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO REIMBURSE THE RESPONDING AGENCY FOR ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE RESPONSE, INCLUDING EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, AND PERSONNEL.

ENGINE COMPANY RESPONSE: 1ST HOUR, NO CHARGE. EACH ADDITIONAL HOUR WILL BE BILLED AT A RATE OF \$150.00 PER HOUR OF ON SCENE TIME.

PERSONNEL RESPONDING: NO CHARGE FOR FIRST HOUR. EACH ADDITIONAL HOUR OF PERSONNEL TIME WILL BE BILLED AT THE RATE OF 1.5 TIMES THE HOURLY RATE.

EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES USED: REPLACED BY THE SPILLER AT THEIR COST OR BILLED AT COST TO THE SPILLER.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE BUILDING CODE VOLUME V, FIRE PREVENTION AND IN PARTICULAR, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 105.6 PERMITS ARE REQUIRED TO BE ISSUED FOR CERTAIN OPERATIONS AND PROCESSES. THIS LIST DETAILS THE MANDATORY PERMITS REQUIRED TO BE ISSUED BY THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE.

 - a. PRODUCTION, STORAGE, TRANSPORT, DISPENSED OR USED
 - b. INSTALL, ALTER, REMOVE, ABANDON, OR PLACE OUT OF SERVICE FOR MORE THAN 90 DAYS ANY ABOVE OR BELOW GROUND TANK
 - c. TO CHANGE THE TYPE OF CONTENTS STORED IN A FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE TANK TO A PRODUCT THAT POSSESS A HIGHER DEGREE OF HAZARD THAN THE PREVIOUS PRODUCT.
 - d. MANUFACTURE, PROCESS, REFINE, OR BLEND FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS
 - e. TO ENGAGE IN THE DISPENSING OF LIQUID FUELS INTO FUEL TANKS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, GOVERNMENTAL, OR MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS
 - f. TO UTILIZE A SITE FOR THE DISPENSING OF LIQUID FUELS INTO THE FUEL TANKS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, GOVERNMENTAL, OR MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS
- 105.6.20 FUMIGATION AND THERMAL INSECTICAL FOGGING
- 105.6.27 LIQUID OR GAS FUELED VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT IN ASSEMBLY BUILDINGS
- 105.6.35 PRIVATE FIRE HYDRANTS-OPERATIONAL PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR THE REMOVAL FROM SERVICE, USE, OR OPERATION OF PRIVATE FIRE HYDRANTS.
- 105.6.36 PYROTECHNIC SPECIAL EFFECTS MATERIAL(USE AND HANDLING OF SAME)
- 105.6.41 SPRAYING OR DIPPING OPERATION USING FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS
- 105.6.43 TEMPORARY MEMBRANE STRUCTURE, TENTS AND CANOPIES(TENTS IN EXCESS OF 200 SQ FEET AND CANOPIES IN EXCESS OF 400 SQ FEET)

OTHER PERMITS LISTED IN SECTION 105 AS *OPTIONAL* MAY BE ISSUED BY THE FIRE OFFICIAL WHEN THE SITUATION WARRANTS. IN THE EVENT THESE PERMITS ARE ISSUED THE SAME FEE SCHEDULE WILL APPLY TO PERMIT ISSUANCE.

**SECTION 105.7 OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE REQUIRES THAT A
A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT BE ISSUED FOR WORK TO BE PERFORMED AS
DESCRIBED IN THE PERMIT LISTINGS**

- 105.7.1 AUTOMATIC FIRE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEMS(INCLUDES SPRINKLER SYSTEMS AND FIXED FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS)
- 105.7.2 COMPRESSED GASES(AMOUNTS IN EXCESS AS LISTED IN TABLE 105.6.9 REQUIRE A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT)
- 105.7.3 FIRE ALARMS AND DETECTION SYSTEMS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT
- 105.7.4 FIRE PUMPS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT
- 105.7.5 FLAMMABLE AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS
 - 1. RELATED TO THE INSTALLATION, CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION OF TANK VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT, TANKS, PLANTS, TERMINALS, WELLS, FUEL DISPENSING EQUIPMENT, REFINERIES, DISTILLERIES, AND SIMILAR FACILITIES WHERE FLAMMABLE AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS ARE PRODUCED, PROCESSED, TRANSPORTED, DISPENSED, OR USED)
 - 2. TO INSTALL, ALTER, REMOVE, ABANDON, PLACE TEMPORARILY OUT OF SERVICE(FOR LESS THAN 90 DAYS) OR DISPOSE OF A FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS TANK
- 105.7.7 INDUSTRIAL OVENS AS DETAILED IN CHAPTER 21 OF VOLUME V
- 105.7.12 TEMPORARY MEMBRANE STRUCTURES, TENTS AND CANOPIES. REQUIRED WHERE THE TEMPORARY MEMBRANE STRUCTURE OR TENT IS IN EXCESS OF 200 SQ FEET OR FOR A CANOPY IN EXCESS OF 400 SQ FEET.
