§ 74.01 CROSSINGS.

Every railroad company whose track shall cross any street or sidewalk in the city shall keep the crossing, for at least the width of the right-of-way, in good condition and repair.

§ 74.02 SPEED.

The speed of any railroad train or locomotive shall not exceed 35 miles per hour at any place within the city.

(90 Code, § 17-2) Penalty, see § 70.99

§ 74.03 BLOCKING STREETS.

No engineer, conductor or other employee of a railroad shall stop any train or locomotive across any street or sidewalk for a longer period than five minutes.

(90 Code, § 17-3) Penalty, see § 70.99
