

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received a subgrant application for City of Roxboro, South Hyco Creek Pump Station #1737908. Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under FEMA Public Assistance Grant Program.

Under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), federal actions must be reviewed and evaluated for feasible alternatives and for social, economic, historic, environmental, legal, and safety considerations. - Executive Order (EO) 11988 and EO 11990 requires FEMA to consider alternatives - and provide a public notice of any proposed actions in or affecting floodplains or wetlands. This notice may also fulfill requirements under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA).

This notice serves as a project-specific notice for FEMA's funding action located within a Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA). FEMA has determined the only practicable alternative is to fund the proposed scope of work. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

Proposed Work and Purpose:

The City of Roxboro will utilize contracts to repair and restore South Hyco Pump Station's Pumps and Electrical Controls to pre-disaster design, function and capacity within the existing footprint. Repairs include replacing: One Schneider Electrical Main Power Cabinet; Two Auma Actuators (Mod# GS-80.3-FA14 S/N 42224G0031), and Two U.S. Motors (Titan II 400 HP 460 V Pump Motor #7228-BCBH).

Project Alternatives:

- (1) Relocating the South Hyco Creek Pump Station and associated equipment outside of the floodplain was considered; however, the site is functionally dependent on its current location to access and transport raw water and is part of a larger interconnected water system, making relocation not feasible.
- (2) No action would leave the facility in a damaged and non-operational condition, disrupting essential raw water transport and failing to meet system and public service needs.
